At the May meeting, the Committee requested staff bring this item back at the June meeting with clarification of the three levels to the administrative appeal process.

The first level remains a written appeal to the Division Manager. The second level is an appeal to the Assistant Executive Officer (AEO). At this level, both the AEO and LACERA's Legal Office will review the appeal and make a determination. If the applicant disagrees with this determination, the third level will be to request an administrative appeal to the Board of Retirement. The matter would then be placed on the Board of Retirement's agenda, with the Legal Office's analysis and recommendations discussed with the Board in closed session. Prior to the closed session, the applicant would have the opportunity to address the Board in open session.

Mr. Adams made a motion, Mr. Chery seconded, to approve the recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.
